



Festivals of My Country

A TWINS PROJECT PLAN

Aim

This project aims to provide students with the opportunity to research festivals and customs of their country before sharing this information with their TWIN School. It is suitable for a new TWIN Partnership or primary level students.

Method

- A Twin School from Sri Lanka and their Twin School agree to share this project
- The Twins Coordinators set a deadline when the project will be completed and exchanged
- Students brainstorm a list of festivals or customs that are significant to their country
- This list is then divided amongst students or small groups of students so information about all the festivals can be included in this project
- Students then research the festivals from various sources such as books, the internet and discussions with families and friends
- Students then create posters or pages for a 'Festivals of My Country' booklet.
- The project is then exchanged with the Twin School abroad and displayed for all students to enjoy.

The Festivals project can include:

- History of the Festival
- The significance of this Festival to your country
- Traditions of the Festival
- Photos, illustrations or cut outs from magazines
- Recipes of special dishes eaten during the festival
- Quotes from friends and family members about what the festival means to them
