A TWINS PROJECT PLAN

Aim

This project aims to enable TWIN Schools to display colourful and informative TWINS Information Boards that celebrate the relationship with their TWIN School overseas. This board can be adjusted over time enabling all students at the school to appreciate the project exchange that takes place.

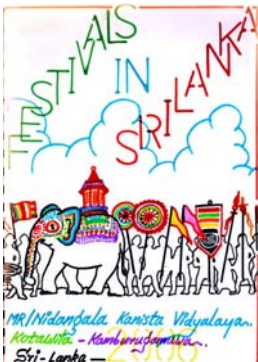


General Overview

Each TWIN School has been given a glass fronted Noticeboard by AdoptSriLanka to display information about their school and their TWIN school abroad.

To begin this project, a selected group of students from each TWIN School works together to design a series of informative and colourful illustrations, short essays and photographs for a display board for their TWIN School.

Students and teachers can share information about themselves and their school with their TWINS School overseas. The project will result in a TWINS Information Board being displayed in each school for TWINS participants to add to and adjust throughout their involvement in TWINS.



Suggestions for TWINS Noticeboards:

- School photographs
- Maps of school, local area or country
- Photographs of students, school facilities, special events or local landscapes
- Examples of student's artwork
- Information about local customs, special celebrations, unique animals, traditional dishes
- Special notices about Student achievements
- Messages from students about what they enjoy about their relationship with their Twin School
- A heading such as "TWINS Schools - Siddhartha College – Sri Lanka and Scots College – Australia"

Tips

- It is important to make an agreement with your TWIN School about working on this project. Each school needs to allocate a suitable space for displaying their TWINS Noticeboard.
- The TWINS Coordinators at each school should agree on a suitable deadline to complete and exchange this project
- The TWINS Coordinators can work with their students to identify a range of ways of displaying information about their school and country for their TWINS overseas
- It is important to remember that there is not much space on a Noticeboard. Make sure you select the most colourful, informative and important items to display
- Include bold headings that can be read from a long distance
- Try to cover a variety of topics that you think will interest your TWIN School
- Try to have a good balance between written information, photos, illustrations and other ways of displaying your information
- The final product will be various small posters, short essays, photographs and illustrations that shares information about their school and country to their TWIN overseas.
- These projects are then exchanged between TWIN Schools and displayed for all students to enjoy and learn from.
