



Our Hobbies!

AN ASL TWINS PROJECT PLAN



General Overview

This TWINS project gives the students in both schools a chance to write about their hobbies and to share their passion for them with their friends overseas.

Method

- The TWINS Coordinators of both schools agree to share this project and set a deadline for its completion.
- This project can be done by students working together (if they have the same hobby) or individually.
- First the teacher should explain the project and have a group discussion to learn about what hobbies the students have and what they enjoy about them.
- Then the students should write about one hobby with as much detail as possible.
- The students could include diagrams, artwork, samples and photos where possible.
- The work can then be collected and collated to produce an informative and attractive project book
- Alternatively, the students might like to work collectively on a series of bright attractive posters that represent all their hobbies.
- The project book should be exchanged between the TWINS schools within the time frame agreed.
- Follow up lessons should be arranged once your TWINS school's project has been received. The teacher should share the project book with the class and discuss the content. Are the hobbies enjoyed by the students overseas the same, if not, how do they differ?

Questions to consider!

- What is it about my hobby that I enjoy?
- Where and how often do I participate in my hobby?
- Is my hobby more enjoyable alone, with my family or with others?
- How did I first get interested in my hobby?
- Do I think that any of the children in my TWINS school would have the same hobby? If not, why not?
- Do I know any famous people that have the same hobby as me?
- Do I take part in any competitions associated with my hobby?
- Do I travel to take part in my hobby?
- What are the benefits of my hobby?
- Is my hobby linked to my culture or national identity?



What will the students learn?

- How to creatively present information that is personal to them.
- Practise writing and art skills. Widen vocabulary.
- Similarities and differences between hobbies enjoyed in each country.
- How to celebrate and share their hobbies.

Summary

This TWINS project is a great way for students to express their passion for a hobby they enjoy and share the information with their peers overseas. This will give an insight into the students' lifestyles in each country and can be linked to the global dimension theme of 'diversity'.
